# CITY BLITZ fast-tracks municipal sustainability options for an ecocounty.

CITY BLITZ is a peer facilitated program developed by countywide Chief Sustainability Officers (CSOs) for sharing best practices and innovating new sustainability solutions throughout Los Angeles. We are developing a prototype initiative that scales models of sustainability, such as the one developed by the <a href="City of Claremont">City of Claremont</a>.

We refine the CITY BLITZ initiative based on what we learn from the prototype period.




Partners share a common interest in creating a more sustainable LA County. Collaborate across silos. Change the game. Get in on the ground floor of a replicable CITY BLITZ model.


